The June Cowboy match looked like it might not happen. The weather was very "iffy" that morning and the weatherman had been hinting for several days that it might rain. Mother Nature was kind to us though and the rain held off until the match was over, and all the targets had been stowed away. Five brave souls decided to chance it and they were rewarded with some good shooting.

Taking first place overall was new Cowboy shooter Rip Rocker. His overall time (adjusted for penalties) was 202.01 seconds with one miss. Not too shabby for firing a total of 50 rounds out of his revolvers, 50 rounds out of his rifle and 20 rounds out of his shotgun. The July match is shaping up to be a good one. It will take place on Sunday, July 9. Registration begins at 8:45 that morning in the Clays house and the match will begin at approximately 9:30. If you've never shot a cowboy match at Fenton the cost is only \$5.00. Be sure to bring eye and hearing protection with you even if you are only going to watch. Of course, there is no charge to watch. You'll be able to see the descriptions for each of the 5 stages we will shoot on our Butcher Butte Bunch Facebook page. They should be available to view around July 1.

Part of the mystique of playing Cowboy is dressing the part. That's easily accomplished though. For the guys, all that is required is a pair of jeans, a long sleeve shirt and a pair of work boots. Sneakers, boots with lugs and baseball caps are not allowed. The gals can dress that way too, or just wear a dress or skirt and blouse. Those are the official rules. For the July match this year we are going to relax that requirement and make it a T-shirt match. If you'd rather wear a T-shirt it won't be counted against you. Long pants and proper footwear are still required.

We'd love to have you come out and join us on July 9 whether it is to play or just to watch. At the beginning of the article is the Cowboy Action Shooting motto. You'll never find a friendlier bunch of people.

SPORTING CLAYS

As the spring league comes to an end, we are gearing up for our first ever Summer Sporting Clays League. Just as with the spring session, the league starts at 6.00pm on a Monday night, there are 8 x 50 bird rounds run over 10 weeks (2 make up nights). You don't need to be an expert to participate, we have had scores in the single digits all the way through to the high 40's in previous leagues.

The average of your first 3 scores set your class for the rest of the League. It is open to members and non-members at \$145.

There will be a Banquet however the date has not been set for both Spring and Summer Leagues combined

We will be starting the summer league on July 10th, come down to the clays house on the 10th and sign up, you can sign up up to 2 weeks past the 10th. See the flyer posted at the end of this month's newsletter.

Red Card

Sporting Clays is now open seven days a week for members with Red Cards. Red cards are available to members to obtain on Saturday's and Sunday's during Sporting Clays public hours.

If you are on the course and one of the clay machines does not fire, move on and make up at the next station and let the desk worker know.

Please do not approach or touch the machines, when they are just sitting there, they are ready to launch and any bump or jarring can release the arm.

RANGE RULES IMPORTANT TO REMEMBER

All guns must be unloaded and benched or holstered before moving forward of firing line. When personnel are forward of firing line no one may be handling a gun for any reason.


