Sunday, May 14, 2023 will be the first Cowboy Action Shooting match at Fenton Lakes Sportsman's Club this year. Registration will begin at 8:45am that day in the Clays house. There will be a mandatory safety meeting at 9:30 followed immediately by the match. We will shoot five stages and since this is the first match of the year, we will keep it simple.

Registration fees are Fenton Lakes members and Wolverine Rangers members: \$14.00; Juniors (under 18) or first time shooting a cowboy match at Fenton: \$5.00. All others: \$20.00. **Since this match also falls on Mother's Day, ladies shoot for FREE.** There is no fee to watch.

You might be interested to know that (according to SASS international headquarters) as of March, 2023 there are a little over 113,000 SASS members worldwide and 522 of those members are active in Michigan. There are 13 clubs in Michigan that host Cowboy matches.

We'd love to have you come out and see what Cowboy Action Shooting is all about. Be sure to bring eye and hearing protection with you.

# MEMBERSHIP RENEWALS

To qualify for the senior membership rate you must be 65 or older at the time of renewal.

### **Expired Membership**

Members who have let their membership lapse and failed to renew within the 15-day grace period will have their membership terminated. Those members must reapply for membership and be approved by the Board of Directors. Any member whose membership has expired for one year or more must retake New Member Orientation.

MEMBERS WISHING TO RENEW THEIR MEMBERSHIP ARE RESPON-SIBLE FOR KNOWING THE DATE OF EXPIRATION OF THEIR MEMBER-SHIP YEAR. EVERYONE IS DIFFERENT (The Membership Manager will send email notifications about expiring memberships but cannot guarantee you will receive them and does not follow up for those who do not "Renew") A "Profile" is created within (<u>www.fentonlakes.com</u>) for each member at the time of application. A member can access and update their own individual "Profile" at any time using their email address as their "Login ID" and the password they created during the application process. **Terminated members will not have access to their profile after their "Renewal Grace Period" is over**. # **SPORTING CLAYS**

### **Red Card**

Sporting Clays is now open seven days a week for members with Red Cards. Red cards are available to members to obtain on Saturday's and Sunday's during Sporting Clays public hours.

### Crusher Challenge

On Saturday and Sunday when you sign up for a round of clays, drop \$1 in the crusher challenge jar and sign your name. We have "smoker clays" hidden in some of the machines around the course. If you pay your buck, sign your name, and hit one you get a free round of 50 clays certificate when you report back to the desk worker. Tell the desk worker what station number you hit it on. The smoker, when hit leaves a cloud of dust in the air, you'll know one when you hit one.

If you are on the course and one of the clay machines does not fire, move on and make up at the next station and let the desk worker know.

Please do not approach or touch the machines, when they are just sitting there they are ready to launch and any bump or jarring can release the arm.

### **RANGE RULES**

### **IMPORTANT TO REMEMBER**

There are many calibers of ammunition prohibited on the indoor range. Please check the list to be sure the cartridge you are using is allowed. The club prohibits any full auto or simulated full auto shooting.

# **EDUCATION**

We have an NRA Personal Protection Outside the Home Class scheduled in June. This is a two day course that takes place over two weekends. The course teaches holster skills and advance shooting skills, including moving and shooting and low-light shooting.

# SIGNING IN AT THE RANGE

One name per line on the sign-in sheet. All visitors to the ranges, members, spouse children, guests, are required to sign in and sign out. You must sign in BEFORE you begin shooting and all guests must complete a release form and pay the guest fee BEFORE shooting. Please adhere to the sign in rules.

## **VOLUNTEERS**

Volunteer help is always needed to keep the club running. 16 work hours a year earns a \$50 discount on your Regular Family Membership renewal dues.

Can you commit to working on a regular basis at the club? Members who regularly participate in the tasks needed to keep the club running can be eligible for discounted worker rate dues. If you can commit to a minimum of 80 hours/year for worker status, contact a club officer to discuss opportunities.
